

OUR LETTER WRITING PROGRAM IS ALSO

WILL NOT LET THE STATE INVISIBLE THEM.




PRISONS AND JAILS ARE HIGHLY INACCESSIBLE TO NON-INCARCERATED PEOPLE—EVEN MORE SO SINCE THE START OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC. NOW, INCARCERATED PEOPLE ARE EXPERIENCING RESTRICTION FROM THEIR LOVED ONES ON TOP OF THEIR ROUTINE FORCED ISOLATION.




LETTER WRITING IS A WAY TO ENGAGE WITH INCARCERATED PEOPLE AND UPLIFT THEIR STORIES.

ESPECIALLY FOR THOSE WITHOUT CONNECTIONS TO THE OUTSIDE, THE SIMPLE ACT OF SOMEONE LISTENING AND REACHING OUT IS A KINDNESS—ONE THE STATE CONSTANTLY ATTEMPTS TO DISRUPT.



IN THE U.S., THERE ARE OVER 2.3 MILLION PEOPLE INSIDE JAILS, PRISONS, CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES, AND IMMIGRATION DETENTION CENTERS.



RIGHT NOW, THERE ARE ROUGHLY 14,500 PEOPLE CAGED IN OREGON STATE PRISONS.
